We explained that this decision has come after concerns over the last few years in relation to safeguarding, which led to the decision to review. We have thought about this as a School very carefully and appreciate that many students will be disappointed. We shared with students that we are now in the process of engaging with them to provide a programme of Year 11 enrichment and privileges which recognises their Year 11 status.
