Term	Alive Theme	What we do	How it helps students to develop that Alive theme
1	We can Research	Students listen to a wide variety of Popular Music styles from the last 100 years and formulate ideas on production techniques.	Students develop a love of research through listening.
2	We value Ourselves	Students compose their own technology-based work, give and receive regular feedback from both teachers and peers and value their own creativity as a result.	Students begin to value the unique Musical creativity they possess.
3	We are Organised	Students are required to organise, timetable and rehearse musicians for a studio-based recording.	Students learn to understand the value of others and how punctuality and organisation enables productivity.
4	We are Interdependent	Students require their fellow students to help contribute to their recording coursework. This requires many instances of co-operation and organisation.	Students realise that in order for productivity, it requires the assistance of fellow students along the way.
5	We are Resilient	Students undertake two exams which require individual awareness and understanding of Music Technology.	Students become more resilient through knowledge of the subject and practical solo application.

3	We are Creative	Students use their own unique creativity to compose Music.	Developing Musical and compositional skills helps students to realise their full creative potential.
