


Disciplinary Literacy



The EEF (Education Endowment Foundation) states that “Disciplinary literacy is an approach to improving literacy across the curriculum” and uses a tree to demonstrate this with wide-ranging branches.

The trunk represents the foundation of effective literacy instruction.

The branches reflect the way in which this takes different directions within different disciplines.

To fully explore what the trunk constitutes it is important to first consider what makes effective teaching especially for those who are furthest behind in their literacy competence.
