Dear Y12 Parent/Carer,

Welcome to St Mary Redcliffe and Temple School Sixth Form. We do hope that the last few weeks of enrolment and the first few days of school have not been too stressful for you as parents/carers. This letter provides some **information about school life** and the **pattern of the year**, including promoting an opportunity to attend a Y12 Parental Briefing on Wednesday 16 September and a 'meet with the tutor' event on Thursday 17 September.

As of this morning students have their **timetables** and will know what time and where they are expected in school each day. In addition to their chosen KS5 subjects, from Monday 14 September students also have **weekly tutor registration sessions** on a Monday (for Group 1) or Tuesday (for Group 2). **Assemblies** will also run weekly on a Wednesday this term and then fortnightly thereafter. Students will know which group they are in by the number that appears at the end of their tutor group on their timetable. 12AK1 for example, as it has a 1 at the end means group 1, but 12JH2, for example, means group 2. Students must be in their registration room for tutor registration and in the common room for assembly by 8.30am on these days and attendance is compulsory to enable us to fully support students to have a happy and rewarding time with us. This week is slightly different to the normal timetable though as Y12 have tutor tomorrow at 9am and then assembly on Thursday at 8.30am.

Sixth Form Book Deposit

Students should now have brought home a letter from the finance team regarding payment of a £30 deposit. This is a book deposit that will be returned when students finish their studies at SMRT. The letter will also introduce you to the online payment system we use at SMRT called 'Scopay'. Also if students would like a locker in the Sixth Form Building please pay a £5 deposit for a key on Scopay.

Y12 Parental Briefing

We would like to invite you to the Sixth Form for a **parental information evening** on Wednesday 16 September to talk you through key aspects of Sixth Form life and give you an opportunity to ask questions. This takes place in the Sixth Form Common Room. Due to the size of a Sixth Form year group, there are two sessions, with one starting at 5pm and one at 6pm. Please sign up to attend one of these sessions using this [survey link](#) to confirm that you will be attending. Students are not required to attend. When you arrive to our Sixth Form building, please enter through the main entrance where you will find our reception and from here you will be directed to our Sixth Form common room. If you cannot attend we will be providing a recording of the presentation after the event.

Meet with the Tutor

On Thursday 17 September all lessons for all main school and Sixth Form students will finish at the end of P3 (12.25pm). This is to allow time for Parents/Carers to meet with tutors and share any important information ready for the year ahead. In Sixth Form, as most tutors have two different tutor groups, one in Y12 and one in Y13, we will be offering each Parent/Carer an opportunity to meet with the tutor through a **5-minute online appointment**. This is providing an opportunity for parents/carers to share any important information for the year ahead. However if you don't think this early appointment is necessary though or this information has already been shared in another way or at another time, please don't feel like you need to make an appointment. Parent/carers though can request more time than this if they think this is needed, by emailing davisk@smrt.bristol.sch.uk and we will do all we can to accommodate. Monday 5 July- Friday 9 July- Y12 Work Experience Week and Geography Coursework

Friday 23 July- Last day of Y12 before the holidays.
