Think about how you could use your chosen material(s) pleat , scrunch, cut into, fold, knit, layer,

Task:

1. Create a garment directly onto a person.
2. Take lots of good photographs.
3. Re create a 'Vogue' cover using your best photo. This can be done easily in Word.

You will need:

- Lots of materials of your choice.
- Cellotape (or something suitable to stick your work)
- A willing volunteer.
- A camera.
