Homework Timetables 2025 - 2026

Years 10 and 11

By Year 10, students should be spending approximately 40 minutes per subject per homework. The amount of homework set on particular weeks may vary in some subjects, e.g. Drama. This timetable allows students to plan their workload, because, in many subjects, there will be a few days between homework being set and handed in. Approximately ten hours of Values in Practice (Vip) homework may be set over the year. All homework will be set using Bromcom

Music homework will tend to be practical in nature, e.g. practising instruments in preparation for performance, working on compositions. The latter may have to be done at school, if students do not have the facilities at home.

Students studying a language should expect homework to be set every lesson as there will always be an expectation to learn vocabulary.

A, B, C and D refer to the student option choices.

The student's personal timetable (issued to each student at the start of term) will indicate what these are. The name of the group e.g. 10B will indicate the option block to teachers.

Homework for twilight GCSEs is set at the teacher's discretion.
