

<b>Data Drop</b>	<b>What assessment(s) informs this data drop?</b>	<b>How is this assessment marked, moderated and feedback to students?</b>
1	Mock exams	Exams are marked by each teacher using the mark scheme from previous exam cycles. Students are given a front sheet with a numerical grade, letter grade and specific feedback about strengths and areas to improve.
2	Unit tests	These are knowledge tests to check grasp of content. Marked in class. Students are asked to resit if they do not hit 60%.
3	Assessed Essays	Students complete an assessed essay per unit, depending on the part of the course. These are given a numerical and letter grade and feedback.

<b>Homework</b>	<b>How is homework used to support learning?</b>	<b>How is homework marked and feedback to students</b>
	In some parts of the course students complete a proof of study knowledge grid. In other lessons HW is used to finish and extend class learning. It is shared in lessons and on Edulink.	Knowledge grids are checked every term. Other HW is used to inform learning and is explored through questioning in class.
